



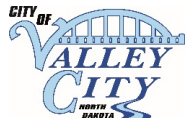

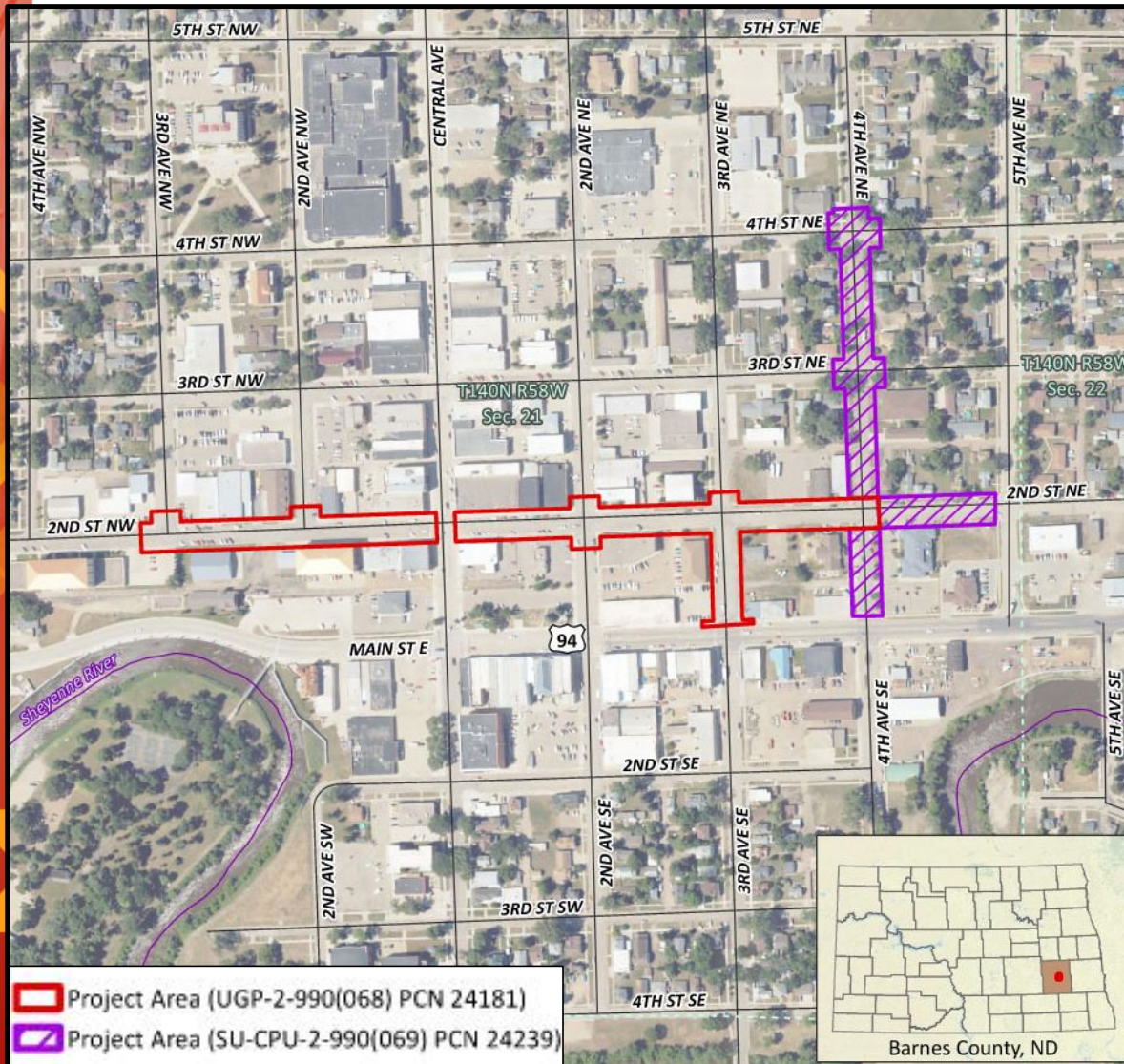

Project Location

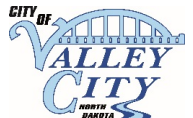
- » **2nd St N**
 - » 3rd Ave NW to 5th Ave NE
 - » Exception at the Intersection of Central Ave N
- » **3rd Ave NE**
 - » Main St to 2nd St NE
- » **4th Ave NE**
 - » Main St to 4th St NE





Project History - Pavement

- » All sections built in early to mid 1900s
- » 2nd St NW – 3rd Ave NW to Central Ave
 - » 2010 – Mill & Overlay
- » 2nd St NE – Central Ave to 3rd Ave NE
 - » 2002 – Mill & Overlay
- » 2nd St NE – 3rd Ave NE to 5th Ave NE
 - » 2010 – Mill & Overlay
- » 3rd Ave NE
 - » 1979 - Overlay
- » 4th Ave NE
 - » 1979 – Overlay
- » 2016 Upper Great Plains Transportation Institute Needs Assessment
 - » Fair to Poor Condition



Existing Roadway

- » Varying Roadway Widths from 40' to 56' Curb to Curb
- » Sidewalk accommodations
- » Diagonal and/or Parallel Parking



Roadway Deficiencies

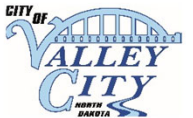
- » Poor Pavement Condition
- » ADA Deficient Sidewalks
 - » Excessive Cross Slopes
 - » Lack of Pedestrian Ramps
- » Lighting Deficiencies



Project History – Water Main

» Water Main

- » 8" PVC/12" PVC (1989/2009)
 - » 2nd St N (3rd Ave NW to Central Ave)
- » 6" SC (1922)
 - » 2nd St N (2nd Ave NE to 5th Ave NE)
- » 8" AC (1970)
 - » 3rd Ave NE (Main St to 2nd ST NE)
- » 4" SC/6" CC (1922/1961)
 - » 4th Ave NE (Main St to 4th St NE)



Project History – Sanitary Sewer

» Sanitary Sewer

- » 12" CIPP (2010)
 - » 2nd St N (3rd Ave NW to 2nd Ave NW)
- » 18" VCT (Estimated 1922)
 - » 2nd St N (2nd Ave NE to 5th Ave NE)
- » 10" VCT (Estimated 1922)
 - » 4th Ave NE (2nd St NE to 4th St NE)



Project History – Storm Sewer

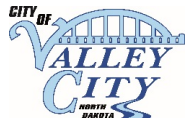
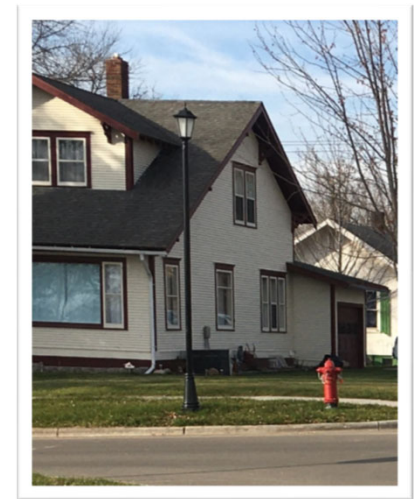
» Storm Sewer

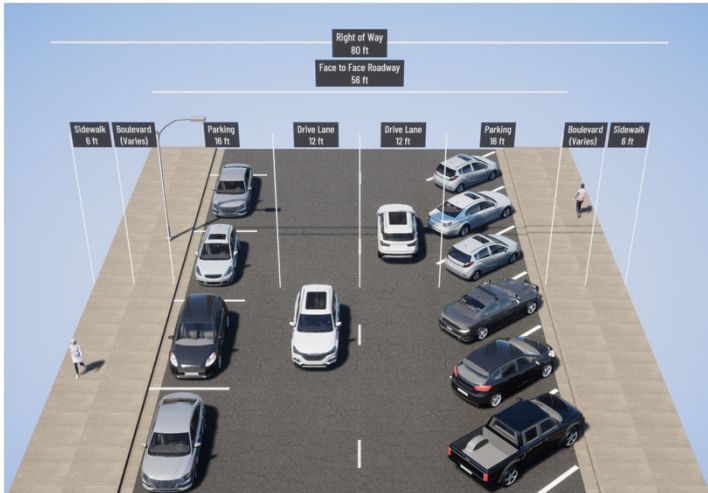
- » 54” RCP (1991)
 - » 2nd Ave NW Crossing
- » 48” to 54” RCP (1967)
 - » 2nd St N (2nd Ave NW to 2nd Ave NE)
- » 18” RCP (1985)
 - » 2nd St NE (2nd Ave NE to 3rd Ave NE)
- » 15” RCP (1971)
 - » 4th Ave NE (Alley to 3rd St NE)



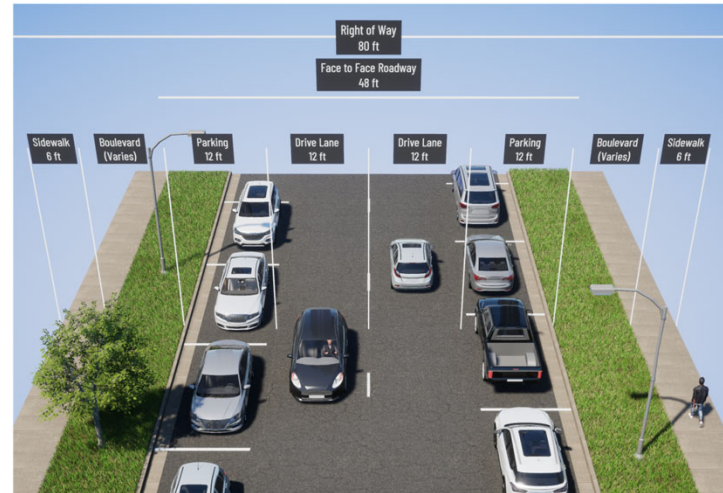
Proposed Improvements

 - » Decorative or Residential Lighting

- » Water Main Improvements
- » Sanitary Sewer Improvements

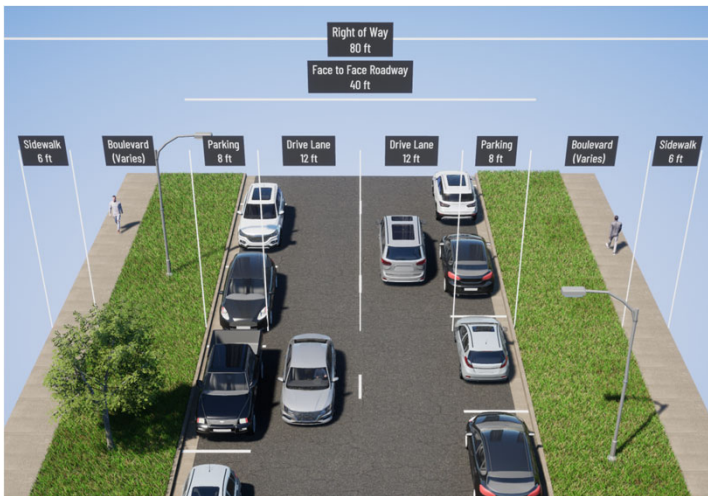




» 2nd Street N
 (Between 3rd Ave NW & 2nd Ave NE)

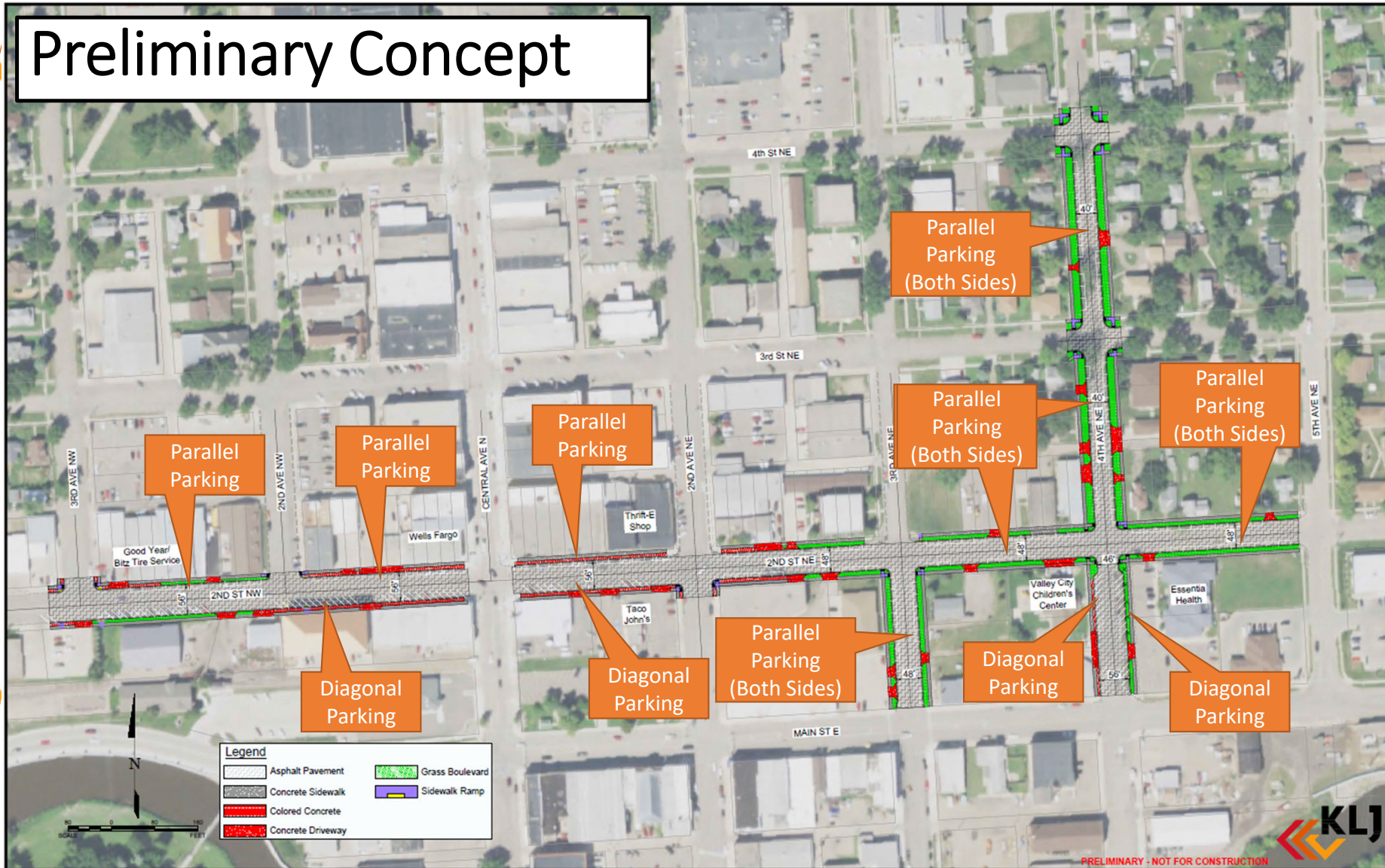


» 2nd Street NE

ND Department of Water Resources

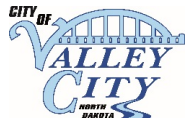
- » Municipal Water

- » R&R Fund – City Sales Tax, Franchise Fees and Utility Fees
- » Prairie Dog Fund – State Funding for Non-Oil Producing Counties
- » Total - \$3,946,381

Special Assessments

- » \$1,184,019



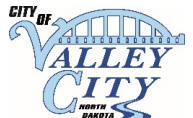
