Public Hearing on Dangerous Building Located At 454 Viking Dr, Valley City.

Declare Public Hearing Open

The commission discussed the potentially dangerous building at 454 Viking Drive. Scott Cole and Shaun Cole, owners of the property, were present and provided a plan to secure and finish the building. The building remains unfinished and still poses some hazards, though some repairs have been made and work is actively progressing. The commission discussed allowing the owners to continue the work, with a deadline of October 31, 2026, to ensure the building is secured and brought up to code.

Commissioner Magnuson declared a conflict of interest, recused himself from the matter, and abstained from voting.

City Administrator’s Report

City Administrator Crawford provided an update on the Public Works Service Center project, noting it remains on schedule and within budget. The final plans for the perimeter fence, including barbed wire similar to the substation, have been approved and remain within budget.

City Updates & Commission Reports

Police Chief Horner gave a reminder to everyone that school is starting, meaning school buses will be back on the roads. Drivers are urged to follow bus safety laws; red flashing lights require all traffic to stop until the stop arm retracts. Everyone should also watch for children walking to and from school, use extra caution at crosswalks, and allow pedestrians to fully cross before proceeding. Additionally, Chief Horner clarified that the parking lot south of the HAC is reserved for business parking only; students who park there may receive a \$20 citation.

City Engineer Petersen reported that construction for Paving Improvement 133 has been delayed. The seal coat portion of the project will not occur in 2026 and has been moved to 2027. The mill and overlay work will still take place in 2026 but has been postponed until after Labor Day. Additional updates will be shared on social media once a definitive start date is confirmed.

City Engineer Eslinger reported on the progress of the new water tower, noting a concrete foundation cap will be placed over the piling for the steel part of the tower and work is expected to start in the next few weeks. The overall project remains on schedule.

Called to Order

President Bishop called the meeting to order at 2:30 pm.

Roll Call

Agenda Items

Recognition: Sam Nielsen-Public Works.

Operations Super Intendent Klemisch introduced new employee Sam Nielsen.

Discuss Paving and Waterfront Meadows

The council discussed requests from waterfront homeowners to pave the street and reviewed the estimated costs for paving within the subdivision, with potential special assessments per lot. The discussion noted that the existing developer agreement addresses paving and may place responsibility on the developer, while proceeding with assessments could significantly affect nearby property owners who are not part of the agreement. The council also discussed the importance of supporting future development in the area.

Review Monthly Expenditures Reports.

Discuss Housing Incentive.

Jennifer Feist, VCBC Development, discussed the Home Buyer Assistance Program with the commissioners. The housing program was established to help increase housing construction, attract new residents, and make homeownership possible for families who otherwise could not build. There was also discussion about focusing more on affordable homes for young families.

Discuss Data Center Regulations.

The commission discussed preparing for potential data center development. Although no project is currently proposed, it was recommended to establish guidelines in a moratorium so the city can have regulations in place before being approached by developers.

Discuss Construction Delays and Proposed Timeline for Seal Coat Work Associated with Paving 133.

City Engineer Peterson and the commissioners discussed the delay on Paving Project 133 and the options available to address it. KLJ will be working on a change order to be approved at a future meeting.

Department Reports

Sanitation Department: Supervisor Swart reported that they are getting quotes for scale repairs and improvements, including a possible portable scale to use during repairs. Several trucks have needed repairs, with two back in service and another still being worked on. Electronics were also hauled to Jamestown for disposal. She reminded residents that only tree branches should be placed at the grass sites; processed wood must be taken to the Transfer Station.

Water Department: Water Treatment Superintendent Hesch reported that summer operations are still ongoing. He also reported on the water usage for June and July.

Electric Department: Electrical Superintendent Senf reviewed outages for the month and updated the commissioners on the progress of summer projects.

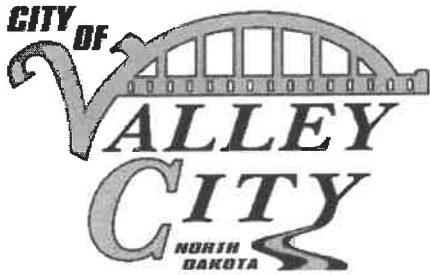
Fire Department: Fire Chief Magnuson reported on the chief calls for the month and provided an update on dangerous buildings.

Police Department: Police Chief Horner reported that all department vehicles are back in service. Officers also conducted room-clearing training with the Sheriff's Office and Highway Patrol, along with cybersecurity training at the HAC. Due to the positive response, the department is considering offering additional cybersecurity education for students in the future.

Street Department: Operations Superintendent Klemisch provided updates on finishing school zone and crosswalk painting before school starts and will then begin hot-mix repairs on East Main Street and other areas. The city's sanitary sewer and lagoon systems passed the annual DEQ inspection, and fall hydrant flushing will begin August 31. Work has also started on the new inert cell while the old cell is being capped.

Compared to a "Local Permit," an organization or group with a "Restricted Event Permit" may conduct three more game types, but is restricted to one event per year, must file a "Report on a Restricted Event Permit" with the city or county and Office of Attorney General, and disburse net income to eligible uses. These uses are described by North Dakota Century Code 53-06.1-11.1(2) and North Dakota Administrative Code 99-01.3-14-02. Refer to the backside of the "Report on a Restricted Event Permit" form for a general list of eligible uses.

For a Restricted Event Permit, one method to ensure that the total of all cash prizes and retail value of all merchandise prizes do not exceed \$50,000 is to charge each player a standard amount at the start of the event for a certain number or value of chips. If a player loses all of the player's chips, the player may re-buy chips. The player would play games and, at the end of the event, the organization would auction merchandise prizes to the players. The player who bid the highest number or value of chips for a prize would win that prize. For those players who have chips but did not successfully bid on a prize, the organization may redeem the chips for a predetermined cash value per chip. For this method, the value of the players' chips redeemed for cash is no prize.

RESOLUTION NO. 2535

A RESOLUTION IMPOSING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON CITY APPROVALS FOR DATA CENTERS AND ON THE CITY'S EXECUTION OR APPROVAL OF RELATED NONDISCLOSURE AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Valley City may receive inquiries and applications regarding the siting and operation of Data Centers within the City limits and within the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Data Centers, by their nature, may present substantial and unique land use, infrastructure, environmental, public safety, and fiscal considerations, including but not limited to electrical power demand and distribution capacity, water supply and wastewater capacity, stormwater management, air emissions and noise, heat generation and dissipation, traffic and transportation impacts, compatibility with surrounding land uses, fire and life-safety risks, law enforcement and emergency response demands, and potential effects on tax base and municipal finances, and

WHEREAS, the City's current ordinances, plans, standards, and procedures may not adequately address the cumulative and project-specific impacts associated with Data Centers; and

WHEREAS, a temporary pause on approvals is necessary to allow the City sufficient time to study and evaluate the potential impacts of Data Centers; to review and, as appropriate, update the City's comprehensive plan, zoning and land use regulations, development standards, building and fire codes as applicable, and related permitting procedures; to assess and plan for electric, water, wastewater, stormwater, transportation, and other infrastructure and utility needs; to evaluate environmental and noise impacts; to review public safety, emergency response, and community health implications; to analyze fiscal impacts, fees, and cost recovery; and to develop appropriate regulations, policies, and guidance to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, during the study period, the City also finds it necessary to refrain from executing or approving nondisclosure agreements related to proposed Data Center projects, in order to maintain transparency, preserve the integrity of the City's planning processes, and avoid precommitments that could undermine the City's regulatory evaluation and policymaking; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to impose this temporary, time-limited moratorium as a reasonable measure to maintain the status quo while the City undertakes the foregoing work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF VALLEY CITY, BARNES COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Definitions.

For purposes of this Resolution, the following terms shall have the meanings set forth below:

"Data Center" means a facility, building, or group of buildings used primarily to house, store, process, manage, or transmit digital data, including but not limited to computer servers, networking equipment, and associated infrastructure, together with support areas such as mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems, energy storage, cooling systems, backup generators, and security or administrative areas. "Data Center" includes facilities commonly referred to as data processing

centers, cloud computing centers, colocation facilities, cryptocurrency or digital asset mining operations, high-performance computing centers, or similar uses where the principal use is the operation of computing or data processing equipment. “Data Center” does not include incidental server rooms or information technology closets accessory to another principal use on the same premises where data processing is clearly subordinate to and supports the principal non–data center use.

“Permit or Approval” means any City-issued or City-approved authorization, consent, or entitlement required for the location, development, construction, establishment, enlargement, modification, or operation of a use or facility, including but not limited to zoning approvals, conditional use permits, variances, site plan approvals, subdivision or plat approvals, building, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, grading, right-of-way, driveway, or sign permits, occupancy permits, development agreements, utility service commitments or will-serve letters, franchises, and any other similar municipal approvals, whether administrative, quasi-judicial, or legislative in nature.

“Extraterritorial Jurisdiction” means the area outside the City limits within which the City of Valley City is authorized by law to exercise planning, zoning, subdivision, and related regulatory authority.

“Nondisclosure Agreement” or “NDA” means any agreement, contract, memorandum of understanding, or other instrument by which the City agrees to restrict disclosure of information relating to a proposed Data Center project, whether mutual or unilateral, regardless of title or form.

Section 2. Moratorium; Scope.

There is hereby imposed a moratorium for the period specified in Section 5 during which:

The City shall not accept, process, review, approve, issue, or finalize any Permit or Approval for a Data Center within the City limits or within the City’s Extraterritorial Jurisdiction, including but not limited to any application to establish a new Data Center, to expand or intensify an existing Data Center, or to convert an existing use to a Data Center.

The City shall not negotiate, execute, approve, or become a party to any Nondisclosure Agreement relating to any proposed Data Center project within the City limits or within the City’s Extraterritorial Jurisdiction.

During the moratorium term, any application or request falling within the scope of this Section received by the City shall be deemed incomplete and held in abeyance without processing, and any applicable processing timelines are tolled until the moratorium expires or is earlier lifted as to the affected application.

Section 3. Exceptions and Vested Rights.

The moratorium established by this Resolution shall not apply to the following:

Permits or Approvals necessary to address an emergency condition presenting an immediate threat to public health, safety, or welfare, as determined in writing by the City Administrator or designee.

Permits or Approvals solely for routine maintenance, repair, or like-for-like replacement of

existing equipment or structures at an existing Data Center, provided such activity does not increase building area, electrical load, water or wastewater demand, noise or environmental emissions, or otherwise expand or intensify the use.

Permits or Approvals for uses that are not Data Centers, including incidental and accessory information technology rooms or equipment that are clearly subordinate to a principal non-data center use on the same premises.

The issuance of a certificate of occupancy for a structure or phase that has received all necessary Permits or Approvals prior to the Effective Date, where no further discretionary approval related to Data Center use remains outstanding.

Applications determined by the City to be both legally vested and complete prior to the Effective Date under applicable law. Any claimed vested right shall be supported by a written determination by the City Attorney and City Administrator confirming vesting.

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to prohibit the City from communicating with applicants or property owners, or from conducting studies, adopting interim policies for study purposes, or developing proposed regulations during the moratorium period.

Section 4. Administration and Enforcement.

The City Administrator, the City Engineer/Planner, City Attorney, and their respective designees are authorized to administer and implement this Resolution, including making determinations regarding applicability, exceptions, and vesting, and to take necessary actions to carry out the intent of this Resolution. Violations of this Resolution may be enforced by any remedy available at law or in equity, including but not limited to withholding, suspension, or revocation of Permits or Approvals; issuance of stop-work or cease-and-desist orders; civil penalties as provided by ordinance; and injunctive relief.

Section 5. Term; Extension.

The moratorium established by this Resolution shall commence on the Effective Date and shall remain in effect for six (6) months thereafter, unless earlier terminated by the Board. The Board may extend the moratorium for additional period(s) upon the adoption of a resolution or ordinance finding that additional time is reasonably necessary to complete the studies, evaluations, and regulatory updates described in the recitations above. Any single extension shall not exceed six (6) months. Nothing herein precludes the Board from modifying or lifting the moratorium, in whole or in part, by resolution or ordinance prior to expiration.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval on this 1st day of September, 2026.

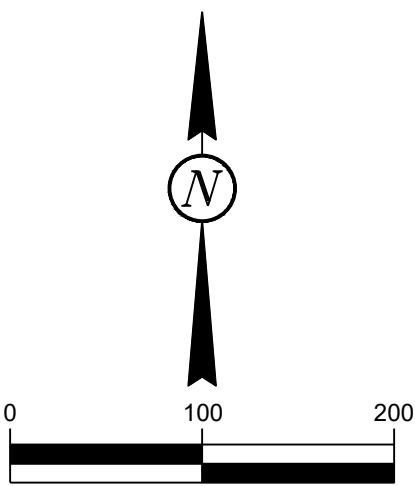

Objective: Approve a replat application to combine two lots into one lot, vacate existing utility easements, and establish new utility easements

Property Owner: Valley City Public School District

Legal Description: Lots 1 & 3 Hanna Field Addition to the City of Valley City located in part of Section 21 Township 140 North, Range 58 West within the City of Valley City

Project Location: The property is located on the east side of Central Avenue between 9th Street NE and 12th Street NE (The map below outlines lot 3; lot 1 contains the existing elementary school and parking lot to the left of lot 3).



Plat Application Analysis: The parcels involved in this plat request are zoned R-4 Multi-Family Residential District and are the site of the new grade 3-12 school building being constructed in Valley City. The applicant wishes to clean up the legal description for the school campus and combine both existing lots into a single lot while removing easements that do not have value and adding new easements needed for the utilities on site. Elementary schools, junior high schools, and high schools are a permitted use in the R-4 District. The proposed construction site was previously granted variances from landscaping and buffer requirements pertaining to the placement of hedges and the tree canopy coverage.

The proposed preliminary plat and construction plans conforms with the remainder of the R-2 District zoning requirements. When initially reviewed this plat needed some minor corrections to meet the subdivision requirements. Based on comments received from city staff and planning staff review these include:

1. Verify location of fire hydrant and any related easements required.
2. Verify correct location for all new easements
3. Address previously identified questions pertaining to exterior lot line and related street and access design.
4. Confirm necessary stormwater system is properly documented.
5. Verify correct language is included for the Owner's Certificate
6. Correct City Commission Approval signature line

Findings of Fact:

1. The existing and proposed land use is consistent with current zoning.
2. The proposed lot, buildings, and construction plans meet all applicable setback and yard requirements.
3. Easements required for certain utilities are being established.
4. Corrections to Owner's Certificate and City Commission Approval are needed

Recommended Motion:

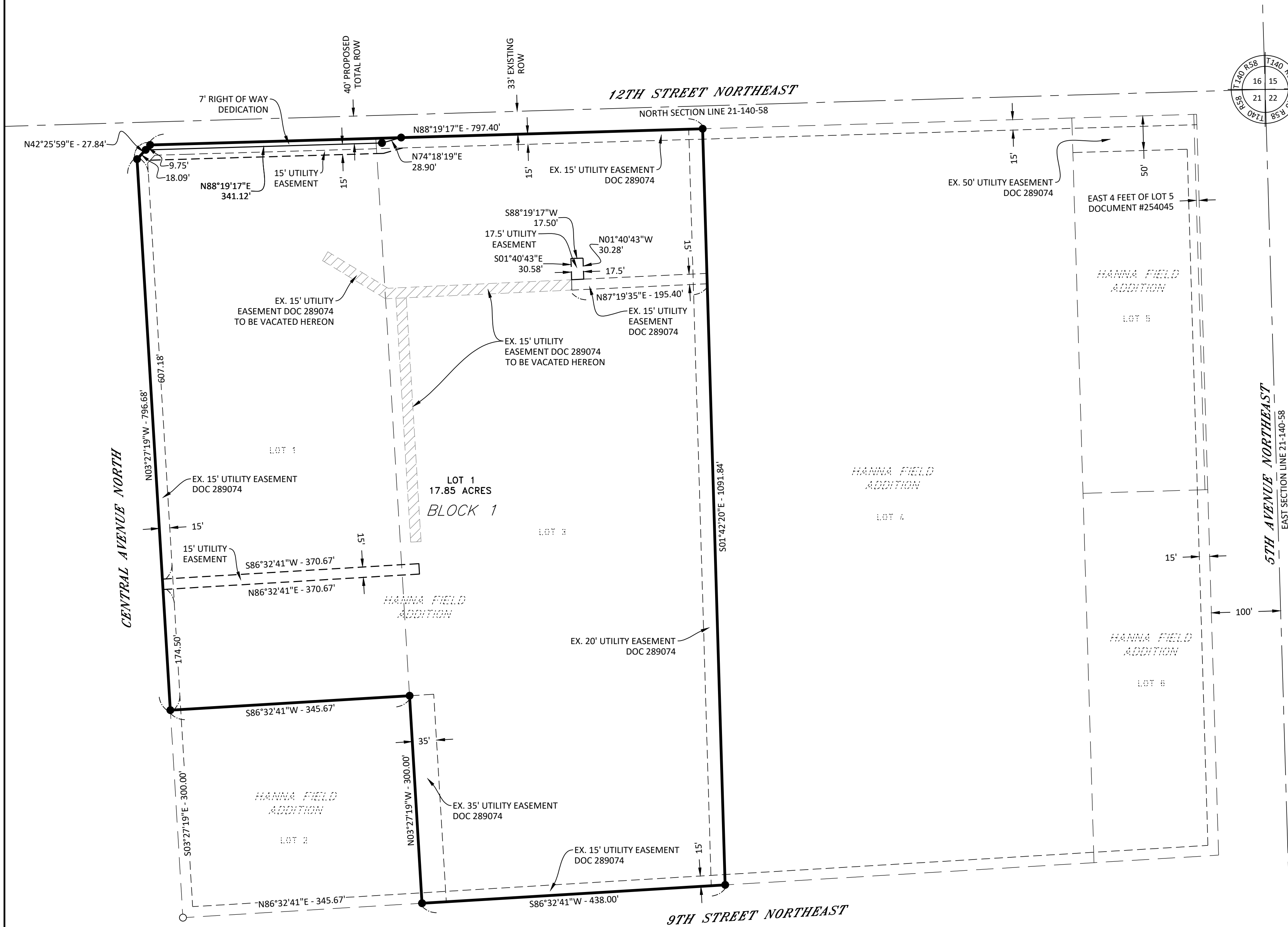
Subject to additional information identified during the public hearing for this plat application, it is recommended that the plat be approved with conditions. A motion to approve the plat application could be worded as follows:

TO THE CITY OF VALLEY CITY, NORTH DAKOTA

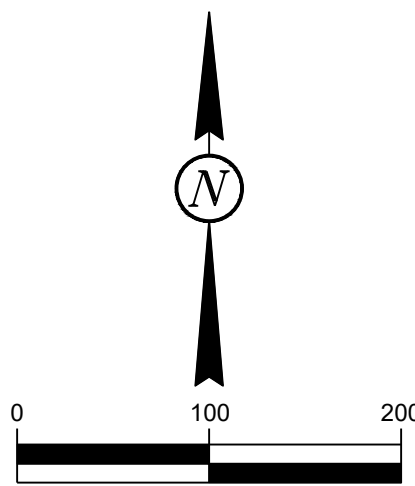

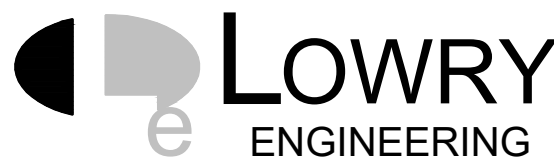

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between the County of Barnes North Dakota, and the City of Valley City, North Dakota, acting by and through their Boards of Commissioners.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Barnes County Board of Commissioners and the City of Valley City Board of Commissioners believe that it is necessary to replace structure number VC04 (Viking Bridge) and realign existing watermain lines; and

WHEREAS, North Dakota Century Code NDCC 54-40.3 authorizes the Barnes County Board of Commissioners and the City of Valley City Board of Commissioners to enter into agreements with any political subdivision of North Dakota.

WHEREAS, Barnes County Board of Commissioners and the City of Valley City Board of Commissioners have determined it to be mutually beneficial for this structure replacement and watermain relocation project to be let and constructed with each entity paying their respective local shares of construction and construction engineering.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I - CONSTRUCTION

Section A. Direction, Supervision, and Inspection of Construction

The construction work contemplated herein shall be under the direction and supervision of the Highway Superintendent of Barnes County.

Section B. Plan Changes and Extra Work

Any plan change or extra work performed hereunder shall become the responsibility of the respective Entity for which project the plan change or extra work was performed, and the total cost of plan changes or extra work shall be assigned, approved and paid for by the Entity for which the plan change or extra work was performed.

ARTICLE II - BASIS OF PAYMENT

Section A. Engineering

Barnes County, as the lead agency, has performed the project surveying and preliminary engineering, including environmental permits, historical reports, and design of the structure replacement and watermain relocation project. Construction Engineering has been contracted by NDDOT with KLJ Engineering. Costs will be split with Barnes County paying 10% of total engineering costs minus the non-participating portion of which 100% of non-participating costs will be covered by City of Valley City.

Section B. Construction Costs

Upon satisfactory completion of the project in accordance with Article I hereof, Barnes County shall reimburse the NDDOT for the full and complete share of the local costs of constructing the project based on the final estimate of cost of the construction work item quantities. Barnes County shall coordinate with NDDOT to prepare and pay the contractor all partial payments as required by the NDDOT specifications and bid proposal of the aforesaid contract. The City of Valley City shall reimburse Barnes County for all non-participating contract obligations attributable to the City of Valley City's share of the project upon receipt of copies of monthly partial estimates and final payment vouchers from Barnes County.

ARTICLE III - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section A. Contract Administration

Barnes County will assume the administrative function in construction, inspection, documentation, contract payment, and any other function pertaining to the project, and will furnish the City of Valley City with copies and supporting data for the project.

Section B. Maintenance Responsibilities

Following the conclusion of construction activities, each entity will take over full maintenance responsibilities for their respective portions of the project.

Section C. Claims

It is hereby understood and agreed that any and all employees and all other persons employed by each respective Entity in the performance of any work or services required or provided for herein shall be considered employees of the respective Entity only, and that any and all claims that may or might arise under the workers' compensation laws of either state on behalf of said employees while so engaged, and any and all claims made by any third parties as a consequence of any act or omission on the part of said Entity's employees while so engaged on any of the work or services to be rendered herein by the respective Entity, shall in no way be the obligation or responsibility of the other Entity. Each Entity agrees to protect, hold harmless, defend, and indemnify the other Entity for any and all claims, causes of action, and damages of any nature whatsoever arising from, allegedly arising from, or related to the provision of work or services to the respective Entity by any third party under the terms of this Agreement or under any contracts awarded pursuant to the terms of this Agreement. Further, if any claim is asserted against either Entity by any third party for work or services provided under the terms of this Agreement or under contracts awarded pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, the Entity against which the claim is

asserted agrees to immediately provide written notice of said claim to the other Entity, regardless of the nature of the claim or potential responsibility therefor.

Section D. Approval

Before this Agreement shall become binding and effective, it shall be approved by resolution of the Board of Commissioners of both Barnes County and the City of Valley City.
