

RESOLUTION NO. 2075

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ELECTRIC UTILITY RATES

WHEREAS, It is deemed necessary to establish new rates to provide the receipts to fund necessary operations and expenses of the electric utility department of the Public Works Department of the City of Valley City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF VALLEY CITY, BARNES COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA:

1. That the electric rates set forth on the schedule identified as Exhibit A of Resolution No. 2075, attached hereto and incorporated herein by such reference, are hereby adopted to be effective with and applied to all billings issued on or after October 2, 2016.
2. That there will be no transfer to the general fund or other funds or departments of the City from the revenues generated by the increased rates established by this Resolution.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE**

EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective on billings made on or after October 2, 2016.

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available to all residential customers for all single occupancy residential and home uses. The application of this rate schedule may be limited to loads requiring up to 50 KW of capacity.

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

Effective on billings made on or after October 2, 2016.

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available to all the commercial, industrial, multiple occupancy residential, and three-phase services for all uses. The application of this schedule may be limited to loads requiring up to 50 KW of capacity.

Single-phase and three-phase, 60 cycles, at available voltage.

EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective on billings made on or after October 2, 2016.

AVAILABILITY

This rate is available for all electric service of a single character supplied at one point of delivery, where the customer contracts for a demand of not less than 50 KW.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase, 60 cycles, at available voltages. All new connections under this rate shall be three-phase.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be by measurement, and shall be the highest demand indicated during any 15 minute period during the billing period. Any meter registering less than 50 KW demand after 12 months will switch to commercial rates.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Public Works reserve the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor is less than 95%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the measured demand increased by 1% for each 1% by which the power factor is less than 95%.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) must be three-phase.
2. If the service is furnished at primary voltage and metered at primary voltage with the consumer owning the substation equipment serving the installation, a discount of 5% shall apply to the monthly bill as determined by the rates set forth in this schedule. However, the Utilities shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage in which case the discount shall be 3%.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) must be three-phase.
2. If the service is furnished at primary voltage and metered at primary voltage, a discount that represents transformer losses shall apply to the monthly bill. However, Public Works shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage.

OUTDOOR AREA LIGHTING SERVICE**

EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective on billings made on or after October 2, 2016.

AVAILABILITY

Available for outdoor lighting service to individual consumers where service can be supplied from existing facilities of the Utility. The Utility will install, own, operate and maintain the complete lighting installation. Lighting will be provided nightly from dusk to dawn, controlled by photo-electric relay.

BILLING ADJUSTMENT

EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective on billings made on or after October 2, 2016.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all rate schedules.

ADJUSTMENT FOR LOAD MANAGEMENT

If a customer agrees to participate in the load management program and executes an application for electric load management, one or more of the following load management credits may apply to his billing.

1. For controlled dual heating systems and other qualifying loads, a credit of 1.5 cents per KWH for all energy usage on the off-peak meter in the billing months December through May.
2. For controlled water heaters, a credit of \$3.00 per month.
3. For demand based rates, a credit of 1.7 cents per KWH shall be applied to the controlled portion of customer's total load in the billing months of November through April. The controlled portion shall be as measured or as estimated by the Public Works. In no circumstance shall the demand charge credit exceed the customers billed demand charge.
4. For controlled air conditioners, a credit of \$5.00/month for the months of June-August.
